

**Permit for Operation of Oversize or Overweight
Vehicles or for Moving Houses**

The City Manager may issue permits, conditioned as deemed necessary or advisable, permitting the operation of vehicle, or combinations thereof, the width, height, length or weight of which exceeds that permitted by the state law adopted by section 11-1, if such operation will not render the streets dangerous or otherwise impair the free flow of traffic.

No person shall move on, transport over, carry along or convey upon any street of the city any building or anything so heavy as to require the use of skids or rollers for the transporting thereof, unless such person shall have secured a permit to do so from the City Manager.

Before issuing any permit pursuant to this article, the City Manager shall require the applicant to file a bond or evidence of issuance adequate to protect the city from any liability or damage to streets which may arise from the permitted operation.

A permit fee of \$25.00 shall be paid the city before any permit shall be issued under this article; provided, however, that the fee for each blanket permit issued under section 11-117 shall be \$50.00. In addition, for the operation of all vehicles, the weight of which exceeds the limitations prescribed by state law, a person operating the same shall pay \$1.00 for each mile or part of mile such vehicle travels over the streets of the city.

By the acceptance of a permit under this article for the operation of an overweight vehicle, or by the operation of such a vehicle when no permit from the city is required by virtue of the provisions of section 11-118, a person agrees to restore or repair any damage caused by the vehicle to any street or appurtenances thereto.
