



Cedar Grove Cemetery

Cedar Grove Cemetery was established November 15, 1859. Situated in the heart of the City, the 20 acre cemetery is owned and operated by the City of Williamsburg.

The cemetery is open year-round from sunrise to sunset. The Caretaker is on the grounds weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.



- Only Williamsburg City residents, those who physically reside in the City, can purchase in the cemetery. Plot(s) purchased are for use of the owner(s) and their lineal descendants only (parents and children). Former 10-year residents with proof of prior 10 year residency can purchase plot(s) at double the cost.
- Burials are performed Monday through Saturday before 4:00 p.m. Sunday and holiday burials are not allowed.
- The Cedar Grove Memorial Garden is set up for cremation burials only and allows burial of those who are not Williamsburg city residents.
- There is a policy on the type and size of monuments and flat markers. All monuments must be approved by the City, please check before purchasing.
- Flower arrangements, live or silk only, are allowed in the Cemetery. Plantings are restricted per Caretaker's instructions. Cedar Grove does not allow trinkets, keepsakes, statues, etc. and generally will be removed 30 days or sooner.

Plot purchases and burial arrangements are conducted at the City's Public Works office, 401 Lafayette Street weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
