Two handlers are required to participate in the race, one handler to release and one handler to catch. If you need a second handler to release, we may have volunteers available to help with the release, but there is no guarantee. Each of the three divisions are opened to all mini, tween and standard dachshund.

Registration is limited to the first 15 entrances (5 per division) with registration form received via mail. There are only 5 race slots available for each division race (total of 15 racing slots). Day of race walk-ins are welcome, however, once the positions are filled, the race will be closed.

I understand that the City of Williamsburg Parks and Recreation Department will not be responsible for any cost incurred for misbehaved dogs. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The race will be held on the track near the dog park. The “race track” will be 30 yards long. One handler will be holding the dog at the “start” line and the second handler will be at the “finish” line. The coordinator will signal the start of the race and the first handler will release the dog with NO other actions. The second handler can attract the dog’s attention but MUST stay behind the finish line.

- MUST be a genuine wiener dog! All wieners must be classified as a Dachshund breed to be eligible to race. This means NO mixed breeds allowed. We have the right to disqualify any racer if there is a question of breed.
- All dogs MUST have current rabies shots. Owners are required to carry proof of rabies shots with them at the event and will be asked to show if an incident would occur.
- You may enter more than one dog to race. Separate registration must be submitted for each dog to secure a spot on the race schedule.
- NO food (human or dog) permitted in race track area.
- ONLY owner/handler allowed on race track one on start and one on finish line.
- NO releasing racers from your arms all dogs must be released from the ground behind the start line or racer will be disqualified.
- All dogs MUST be on a leash when not racing.
- Owners are required to clean up after their dogs
- NO waiving blankets, signs or large objects at start of race
- All dogs MUST be on their best behavior (no fighting biting or aggressiveness)
- OWNERS AGREE TO BE IN CONTROL OF THEIR DOGS AT ALL TIMES AND WILL NOT LEAVE THEM UNATTENDED.
- Upon submitting registration, you WILL BE agreeing to the Rules & Regulations, WILL BE attending at your own risk and WILL BE dismissing City of Williamsburg of any and all liabilities

Check-in begins 15 minutes prior to your race time. The first heat goes off at 3:30 pm. All wieners must check in at the registration table and pick up their bandana prior to the start of their division race.

The event will include the following heats: Little Links (under 2 years old), Bratwurst (between 2 and 8 years old), and Senior Schnitzel (9 years old and over). Five dogs will race in each heat.
