CALL TO ORDER: 1 PM by Chairperson Pam Legere

PRESENT: Chair Pam Legere; Vice-Chair Cathie Allport; Secretary Tom Mainor; General Registrar Tina Reitzel; ; Republican, Observer , Barbara Null; One voter concerning Provisional Ballot requirement.

Public Comment: EB & GR heard voter seeking clarification of identification required at the polls. Was assured that her IDs were in order and her vote was provisional due to Registrar's non-receipt of absentee ballot. Was concerned due to provisional ballot not inserted into voting machine. Explained procedure and was assured her vote would count after mail ballot status was ascertained by Friday.

REGISTRAR'S REPORT

1. EARLY VOTING IN THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING OFFICE over 45 days accounted for 2200 early votes and 574 Absentee Ballots received. 107 voted using the Curbside Voting opportunity. Three staffed the Registrar's Office for the period, requiring no additional Election Officers. There was only one issue with a political observer the first day, quickly resolved. ON ELECTION DAY, there was a significant increase in angry and rude voters at the Registrar's Office directed at staff. The Registrar indicated most of this arose because the voters expected to vote at the Municipal Building and were frustrated to be directed to their normal precinct in order to vote. In the future, we will attempt to MAKE CLEAR TO VOTERS THAT ON ELECTION DAY THEY GO TO THEIR ASSIGNED PRECINCT LOCATION TO VOTE.
2. There was a POWER FAILURE at 6:45 PM at a critical time Election Day in the Registrar's Office, as well as Fire and Police Departments caused by one faulty switch in the Municipal Building. City Manager, Andrew Trivette and IT Director, Mark Barham responded quickly to GR's call. Power was restored within about 15 minutes thus averting a serious dilemma at the 7 PM closing of the Polls.

Thank you letter should also be sent to Police Chief Sean Dunn for the important and effective day-long Police assistance with traffic at both precincts.

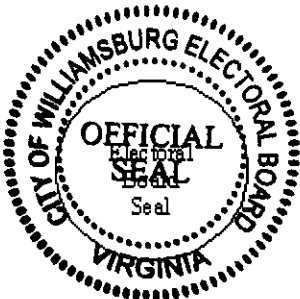
