
Tom Mainor will write a Letter of Appreciation to Williamsburg UMC for their continuing support of Matoaka Precinct voting location.

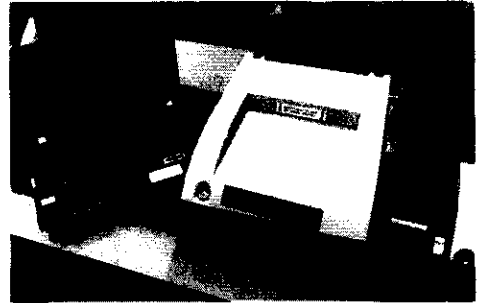

Fiscal Impact Summary: Due to Virginia Election Law we need to establish a 3rd precinct within the City of Williamsburg. The \$38,760 would go towards the purchasing of the new voting equipment to be used at that polling place. The additional cost that would be incurred is \$3,600 for additional officers of election to staff the additional polling place per year. The rental fee is \$300 per year if the polling place isn't a city owned building. Additional supplies and signage will make up \$465 as a onetime cost. Our Electronic Pollbook has an annual licensing fee of \$450.00. By law our office is require to mail out new voter information cards to all voters affected by a precinct change at a one-time cost of \$ 5,500.


