

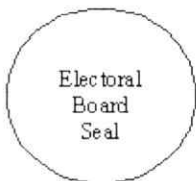

We, the Electoral Board and Director of Elections/Registrar's Office of the City of Williamsburg, have reviewed all the information laid out in our employee handbook and state guidelines for computer and technology use. The Director of Elections/Registrar's staff are within City guidelines for computer security requirements. The Director of Election and staff are required to complete cybersecurity training yearly with both the Department of Elections and City of Williamsburg.
