



## RESOLUTION #21-04

### A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PAVING FUNDS FROM THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager of the City of Williamsburg submitted applications for an allocation of federal funds through the Virginia Department of Transportation Fiscal Year 2021 State of Good Repair Program; and

**WHEREAS**, \$407,150 of these funds requested were granted by the Commonwealth Transportation Board at their October 20, 2020 meeting to fund resurfacing of Jamestown Road (SR 31) from 290 feet east of Lake Matoaka to 160 feet east of Route 199; and


**WHEREAS**, \$335,100 of these funds requested were granted by the Commonwealth Transportation Board at their October 20, 2020 meeting to fund resurfacing of South Henry Street (SR 132) from 340 feet north of William Way to West Francis Street; and

**WHEREAS**, \$258,800 of these funds requested were granted by the Commonwealth Transportation Board at their October 20, 2020 meeting to fund resurfacing of South Henry Street (SR 132) from Route 199 to 800 ft south of College Creek and 70 ft north College Creek to 340 feet north of William Way.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** The City Council of the City of Williamsburg, Virginia, hereby accepts the allocation of \$1,001,050 through the Virginia Department of Transportation State of Good Repair Program.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:** The City Council of the City of Williamsburg hereby grants authority for the City Manager to execute project administration agreements, as well as any other documents necessary, to carry out the State of Good Repair Program.
