



## RESOLUTION #21-10

### A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF WILLIAMSBURG, VIRGINIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2021

**WHEREAS**, the revision of revenues and expenditures for the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, is necessary due to the increase in estimated Sales Tax for Education for FY 2021;

**WHEREAS**, the City will remit the exact amount received from the Commonwealth to the Williamsburg-James City County School System in FY 2021; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Williamsburg hereby amends the budget of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, and appropriates a flexible budget for pass-through of Sales Tax for Education revenue to the Williamsburg-James City County School System, as indicated:
