



RESOLUTION #21-11

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF WILLIAMSBURG'S SHARE OF FUNDING FOR THE WILLIAMSBURG-JAMES CITY COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2022

WHEREAS, the Williamsburg-James City County School Board presented to the Williamsburg City council its estimate of the amount of money needed for the support of the public schools during Fiscal Year 2022. The City's share of support, based in the joint contract between the City of Williamsburg and James City County, is 9.68% for fiscal year 2022; and

WHEREAS, a synopsis of the proposed City of Williamsburg's Budget for Fiscal Year 2022, which included funding for the Williamsburg-James City County Schools, was duly published, and, after public notice duly given, a public hearing with respect tothereto has been conducted by the City Council, after due public notice thereof, and upon consideration of which it is now necessary and desirable to approve the same as prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, City Council delayed the adoption of the budget to June, but that funding pertaining to the schools is required to bge approved before June.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Williamsburg City Council, pursuant to Section 22.1-93 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the City of Williamsburg's share of funding for the Williamsburg-James City County Schools for the Fiscal Year ending Juen 30, 2022 of \$9,214,181 for School Operations and \$828,453 for capital improvements is hereby approved.
