RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSBURG TO END THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY AND DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, the Governor of Virginia declared a state of emergency, Executive Order Number Fifty-One, due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the Director of Emergency Management declared a local emergency, which was confirmed on March 19, 2020 by the the Williamsburg City Council in adopted Resolution #20-06, which confirming a local emergency due to the Covid-19 pandemic and declared a local disaster; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2021, Commonwealth's state of emergency ended; and


WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Management confirms that all emergency actions have been taken and it is now appropriate for the City Council to end the declared state of emergency and disaster declaration pursuant to Sec. 44-146.21 of the Code of Virginia (1950) as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Williamsburg City Council that the local emergency and disaster declaration, initially declared on March 13, 2020 and confirmed on March 19, 2020, be, and is hereby declared **ENDED**.
