A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSBURG, VIRGINIA AS AN ENDORSEMENT OF A FY2023-24 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE PROGRAM PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Williamsburg, Virginia desires to submit an application for an allocation of funds of up to \$1,821,920 through the Virginia Department of Transportation Fiscal Year 2023-24, Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Commonwealth Transportation Board construction allocation procedures, it is necessary that a resolution be received from the sponsoring jurisdiction or agency requesting the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to establish a project to be administered by the City of Williamsburg.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City of Williamsburg requests the Commonwealth Transportation Board to establish a project for the College Woods Circuit Phase 2 project;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The City of Williamsburg hereby commits to provide a minimum 20 percent matching contribution for this project and any additional funds necessary to complete the project;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The City of Williamsburg hereby agrees to enter into a project administration agreement with the Virginia Department of Transportation and provide the necessary oversight to ensure the project is developed in accordance with all state and federal requirements for design, right of way acquisition, and construction of a federally funded transportation project;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The City of Williamsburg will be responsible for maintenance and operating costs of any improvement / facility constructed with Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside funds unless other arrangements have been made with the Department;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: If the City of Williamsburg subsequently elects to cancel this project, the City of Williamsburg hereby agrees to reimburse the Virginia Department of Transportation for the total amount of costs expended by the Department through the date the Department is notified of such cancellation. The City of Williamsburg also agrees to repay any funds previously reimbursed that are later deemed ineligible by the Federal Highway Administration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The City Manager is authorized to apply for funds and to execute project administration agreements, as well as any other documents necessary, for approved projects with the Virginia Department of Transportation.
