CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 1 PM by Chairperson, Pam Legere

REGISTRAR'S REPORT

- **Legislative updates:** Emphasized legislation re/ 10-day post-election delay of FOIA request, and updates on progress and intent of other legislation. Reporting by precinct will mean that each will have a separate ballot-style and sorted by precinct. The latter is a problem. A large logistical problem for larger precincts. Doable for smaller districts as ours but significant added work. CAP results have previously not been sorted by precincts. There are several pieces of legislation proposing that it should be a requirement. Tina has legislative update meeting Feb 4.
- **The Department of Elections has given us the following guidance:**
- *For localities only making numerical changes to districts while not experiencing shifts in boundary lines, a letter from the Electoral Board will suffice in lieu of an Ordinance. The letter from Electoral Board should indicate that redistricting impacts their district assignments, include those specific district details (numbers/names (towns/wards) for addition or subtraction), and detail that no additional changes to their boundaries are required to complete this action.*
- **We need a letter from EB re/ our acceptance of Supreme Court's newly assigned boundaries.**
- **Our Boundary lines are as follow:**
- *(The City of Williamsburg is wholly contained within the same congressional, house and senate districts and we have no splits). We are changing from the 2nd Congressional District to the 1st. We are changing from the 93^d House of Delegates to the 71st House of Delegates. We are changing from the 1st Senate District to the 24th Senate District.*
- *No Boundary lines have changed for the City. The current 2 precincts of Stryker and Matoaka will stay the same.*
- **Redistricting updates:** City Attorney has read over laws. IT—Mark—cannot work with us on precinct maps until March.
- **Motion:** The Electoral Board recommends that we postpone re-aligning of the City precinct lines until after the June Primary. **MOTION PASSED**
- **Letters from Governor/Delegate Mullins:** Shared letter of thanks from outgoing Governor Northam and congratulations from Delegate Mullins for Registrar's Office receipt of *Outstanding Innovation Award* last year.
- **Regional Meeting:** All Registrations confirmed for Homestead. Date March 17-20
- Tina will be out of the office from Feb 28 through March 7th.
- Moving March meeting one week to March 8th.



On behalf of the City of Williamsburg Electoral Board, our redistricting boundary lines are as follow:

In accordance with the Supreme Court of Virginia Redistricting final order and approved maps, in reference to: Decennial Redistricting Pursuant to The Constitution of Virginia, art. II, §§ 6 to 6-A, and Virginia Code § 30-399

The City of Williamsburg is wholly contained within one Congressional District, one House of Delegate District, and one Senate District. The City of Williamsburg is changing from the 2nd Congressional District to the 1st Congressional District. The City of Williamsburg has changed from the 93rd House of Delegates to the 71st House of Delegates. The City of Williamsburg has changed from the 1st Senate District to the 24th Senate District. With no boundary lines changing within the City of Williamsburg, and the current 2 precincts of Stryker located at 401 N. Boundary St. Williamsburg, VA 23185 and Matoaka located at 500 Jamestown Rd. Williamsburg, VA 23185, these two precincts will remain the same.
