



RESOLUTION #22-02

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUND BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF WILLIAMSBURG, VIRGINIA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2022

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan (ARPA) Fund was established to administer funds received from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and to provide continued relief from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, City Council established a framework for the FY 2022 budgets of these funds; and


WHEREAS, City Council now desires to appropriate funding to specific projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Williamsburg hereby amends the ARPA Fund budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, and transfers funding for the purposes as indicated:


