
- **THANK YOU LETTER TO WUMC (MATOAKA)** Tom will write (two copies: one to congregation and pastors, the other to the building manager).

EB MINUTES, CANVASS NOVEMBER 8, 2022 ELECTION

- **ELECTION DAY ISSUES:** The election went smoothly and with but one incident at Matoaka involving an outdoor Political Party Observer accompanying voters into the precinct on a few occasions. This was taken care of quietly and without further incident. Also discussed was the serious matter of the **significant stress level of the 45-day Early Voting Period on the General Registrars.** This has taken a toll on Registrars across the Commonwealth.
- **OFFICERS OF ELECTON** performed exceptionally well in both precincts and CAP. There was discussion of an expressed interest for half-day rather than a full day opportunity by some OEs. The Electoral Board and General Registrar discussed this once more. The decision, given the complexities of Closing issues and signing tapes, etc. as well as transitional difficulties, is that we remain with full day scheduling.
- We anticipate scheduling a meeting with Precinct Chiefs and Assistants with the GR and EB on suggestions for improvements.
