Unsolicited Public Private Transportation Act (PPTA)

Reconstruction of Monticello Avenue

The City of Williamsburg received and accepted an unsolicited proposal under the Public Private Transportation Act (PPTA) guidelines for the reconstruction of Monticello Avenue. The City intends to evaluate the proposal and may negotiate a Comprehensive Agreement with the proposer based on the proposal. The City will accept for simultaneous consideration any competing proposals from interested and qualified Design-Build Teams which comply with the City's PPTA guidelines and which are received by 4:30 pm (local time) on April 24, 2018.

The road project starts at Richmond Road and ends at Mt. Vernon Avenue. The project also includes a multi-use path along Richmond Road from Monticello Avenue to approximately Bacon Street and a multi-use path along Monticello Avenue from approximately Mt. Vernon Ave. to the driveway of W&M's School of Education. The project will be constructed concurrently and in coordination with the redevelopment of the adjacent Williamsburg Shopping Center. The project is to be completed by June 2019.
