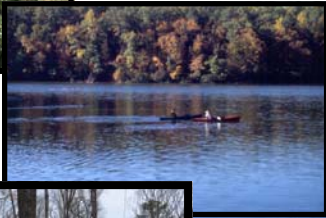
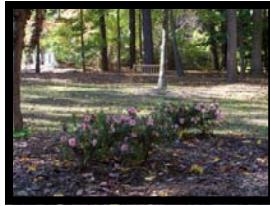

COMMUNITY PARKS



GEDDY PARK

This passive, neighborhood park located at the end of Berkeley Lane.

HIGHLAND PARK COMMUNITY PARK

This 2-acre mini-park is located on North Henry Street in the Highland Park Community. For your enjoyment is a multi-station playground apparatus, a half court basketball court and a picnic shelter with grills where you can enjoy a nice afternoon with friends and family.



STRAWBERRY PLAINS PARK

This .70 acre park is located in the Strawberry Plains subdivision. It contains multi-station playground apparatus, a swing set and several benches. There is also a small open area for children to play kickball, soccer and even football.

WALES PARK

This .172 acre park is located in the Wales subdivision. Provided for use is a multi-station playground equipment and swing set.



WALLER MILL PARK

Located on Rt. 645—Airport Road

The reservoir was constructed in 1942 by the U.S. Government to supply water to Camp Peary, but was declared surplus and sold to the City of Williamsburg in 1945. It provides an average of 3.5 million gallons of water daily to the greater Williamsburg area.

The park opened for public use in July 1972. This 2700 acre facility encompasses a 343-acre reservoir, which is open for fishing, boating, pedal boating, kayaking and canoeing. In 1975 a tunnel was constructed connecting the upper and lower portions of the lake nearly doubling the water acreage available for use.

Four shelters with picnic tables are available on a reservation/fee basis and are the perfect setting for family reunions, graduation parties, or a gathering of friends. The wooded area in the park offers natural trails for hiking plus a 2 1/2 mile paved bikeway. It is a great place to go for a nice outing with the family.

WALLER MILL DOG PARK

The Waller Mill Dog Park is a joint venture between the City of Williamsburg and James City County. Prior to entering the Dog Park, all dogs must be registered at the Operations Building and all owners/handlers must read and agree to abide by the Dog Park Rules. This Park offers a one acre enclosed area with two sections, one for small dogs and one for larger dogs. Both areas have doggie fountains in case your dog gets thirsty and benches for the owners/handlers to sit and rest.

BICENTENNIAL PARK

This passive park is located at the corner of Nassau Street and Newport Avenue, minutes away from Downtown Williamsburg.

A brick walkway surrounds a peaceful green area, where one can bring a picnic and rest after a long day of exploring Colonial Williamsburg. Benches placed around the park offer the perfect place to soak up the sun, sit and read or just visit with a friend.

COLLEGE LANDING PARK

Located on South Henry Street, only a short distance from Bicentennial Park.

After parking in the paved parking area, stroll on the marsh walkway and take in the picturesque view of College Creek; or walk up the steps and view the park and creek from the lookout tower. There are also green areas that are perfect for picnics or just relaxing near the water. If you are a water enthusiast launch your kayak or canoe and enjoy a peaceful paddle around College Creek.

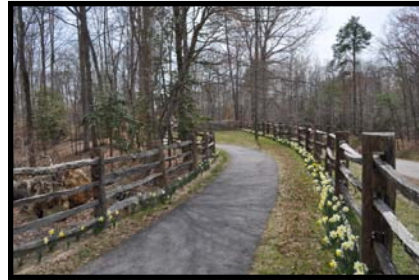


REDOUBT PARK

This Civil War Park is located on Quarterpath Road, off Route 60 East.

After parking in the paved parking area, walk the path over to the observation deck and view the redoubt. The park is open daily from dawn until dusk.

KIWANIS PARK

Kiwanis Municipal Park is located on Longhill Road behind James Blair Middle School.

This 27-acre park includes three lighted softball fields, playground equipment, shelter with picnic tables, basketball court, and seven lighted tennis courts.

QUARTERPATH PARK

Located on Quarterpath Road, off Route 60 East.

This 23-acre facility includes three lighted softball fields; a 25 meter, 6-lane, z-shaped swimming pool with slides; three all-weather tennis courts; two sand volleyball courts; multi-station playground equipment; and a picnic shelter that will accommodate approximately 75 people. The shelter is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

QUARTERPATH RECREATION CENTER

Located on Quarterpath Road, off Route 60 East.

The Recreation Center includes two classrooms and multi-purpose rooms for rent. There are two indoor basketball courts or four indoor volleyball courts. There is also a Game/Activity room available for use during regular hours of operation. Various instructional classes, athletic programs for youth and adults, sports camps, and special events are held throughout the year at this facility.
