PROPOSED VIRGINIA TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT GRANT

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Williamsburg, Virginia will hold a public hearing on behalf of the City of Williamsburg, James City County and York County regarding the joint submission of an application for a Virginia Transportation Enhancement Grant for the Route 60 East Corridor Enhancement Project. The proposed grant will fund highway improvements, landscaping, beautification, pedestrian and bicycle amenities along portions of the corridor, on Route 60 from Colonial Williamsburg to Busch Gardens.

The Public Hearing is being held before the Williamsburg City Council, who will act as lead agent in submitting the proposed application jointly on behalf of the City of Williamsburg, James City County and York County, on Thursday, October 13, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. in the Stryker Building, 412 N. Boundary Street, Williamsburg, Virginia 23185.
